General conditions:

- The Professional Committee reserves the right to change the games schedule and / or the composition of the teams.
- The Competition Formula is final and cannot be changed.
- The Games Rules will follow the most updated Official "Mamanet Rules of the Game".
- POOL with 4 teams:
 - o In the absence of 1 team the pool will run a Double round-robin.
 - In the absence of 2 teams the remaining 2 teams will move to another POOL.
- In case of a deviation from schedule, game times / score will be modified accordingly.
- The teams are responsible for bringing their own balls for warm-up and for the matches.
- Make sure to arrive on time at the correct venue in accordance with the detailed transportation plan
- Each team will arrive 40 minutes before their match starting time and register at the registration table.
- A team that will be late for a match starting time will suffer a technical loss and may be disqualified.
- In any case, a court will not be empty, and if a match ends sooner than expected, the next matches will be expedited in a sweeping manner.
- All the games of all next stages, after the POOL stage, will be posted on the Games Board at the YMCA Sport Center and notified through the Captains' WhatsApp group.





- Each captain will be connected to the WhatsApp group to receive information and especially to be notified regarding the Games Board for the next Stages.
- Dressing code: Tournament shirt, unified colored pants & sports shoes.
- Cut shirts are forbidden a player with a cut shirt will not be allowed to play.
- For any question or clarification, only the captain can address the Professional staff.
- All participants are requested to respect the decisions of the Referees and Professional staff.

Score Calculation Method in the POOL Stage:

- Table Points:
 - O Win 2 points
 - o Loss 1 point
 - Technical Loss 0 points
- In case of a table points tie between the teams, the qualifying team to the next stage will be the one with the highest own Set (Win to Lose) Ratio.
- In case of a Set Ratio tie, the qualifying team to the next stage will be the one with the highest Game Points (Win to Lose) ratio.
- In case of a Game Points Ratio tie, the qualifying team to the next stage will be the winner of a game between the teams.

Score Calculation Method in the other Stages:

- Each team will qualify to the next stage only by winning and losing.
- Except for teams Ranked 25-32 All teams will play only 1 Full game for Final ranking.
- The remaining 24 teams (comprising 75% of all 32 teams) will still have a chance to qualify for the FINALS.





Competition Formula:

Stage 1 - POOLS (48 Games 1-48) - from 2/6/2019 11:30 AM - 2/7/2019 1:50 PM

- The 32 teams are randomly divided into 8 pools (4 teams in each pool) by Toss.
- The pools are named A,B,C,D,E,F,G,H.

- A game is comprised of: 2 sets up to 21, set-3 up to 15, with a 2-point advantage.
- In each POOL All teams will compete through a round-robin tournament to determine the ranking from 1 to 4.
- At the end of this stage, the points accumulated thus far will be reset.
- All teams will be determined as 'Ranked #' (# = 1 through 32) according to their achievements in the POOLS stage and matched inside a single Ranking Table comprised of 1 to 32.
- Teams Ranked 1-8 move directly into the 1/8 FINALS Stage.
- Teams Ranked 9-24 continue to the ELIMINATION Stage.
- Teams Ranked 25-32 continue to the RANKING Stage.

Stage 2 - ELIMINATION (8 Games 49-56) - from 2/7/2019 4:00 PM - 2/7/2019 5:10 PM

- Teams Ranked 9-24 will compete for the right to reach the 1/8 Stage:
 - o Ranked 24 vs. Ranked 9
 - o Ranked 23 vs. Ranked 10
 - o Ranked 22 vs. Ranked 11
 - And so on...
- A game is comprised of: 1 set up to 21 with a 2-point advantage.
- A winning team qualifies to the next Stage: 1/8 FINALS.
- A losing team continues to Ranking Games 17-24.





Stage 3 - 1/8 FINALS (8 Games 57-64) - from 2/7/2019 5:10 PM - 2/7/2019 6:20 PM

- Teams Ranked 1-8 & winning teams from ELIMINATION stage will compete for the right to reach the 1/4 FINALS stage:
 - o Ranked 8 vs. Winner 24/9 from Elimination Stage
 - o Ranked 7 vs. Winner 23/10 from Elimination Stage
 - Ranked 6 vs. Winner 22/11 from Elimination Stage
 - o And so on...
- A game is comprised of: 1 set up to 21 with a 2-point advantage.
- A winning team qualifies to the next Stage: 1/4 FINALS.
- A losing team continues to the Ranking Games 9-16.

Stage 4 - 1/4 FINALS (4 Games 65-68) - on 2/7/2019 at 7:30 PM

- Winning teams from 1/8 FINALS stage will compete for the right to reach the SEMI-FINALS.
 - O Winner 1/16 vs. Winner 8/9
 - o Winner 2/15 vs. Winner 7/10
 - O Winner 3/14 vs. Winner 6/11
 - Winner 4/13 vs. Winner 5/12
- A game is comprised of: 1 set up to 21 with a 2-point advantage.
- A winning team qualifies to the next stage: SEMI-FINALS.
- A losing team continues to the Ranking Games 5-8.

Stage 5 - RANKING GAMES (15 Games 72-85)

- Ranking Games 25-32 will be a Full Game (4 Games 72-75) on 7/2/2019 at 6:20 PM
- Ranking Games 3-24 will be a 1 Set Game (11 Games 76-85) from 2/8/2019 8:00 AM 2/8/2019 10:55 AM

Stage 6 - SEMI-FINALS (2 Games 69-70) - on 2/8/2019 at 8:00 AM

- Winning teams from 1/4 FINALS stage will compete for the right to reach the FINALS.
 - Winner 1 vs. Winner 4
 - Winner 2 vs. Winner 3.
- A game is comprised of: 2 sets up to 21, set-3 up to 15, with a 2-point advantage.
- A winning team qualifies to the next stage: FINALS.
- A losing team continues to the Ranking Games 3-4.





Stage 7 - FINAL GAME (1 Game 71) - on 2/8/2019 at 11:30 AM

- Winning teams from SEMI-FINALS stage will compete in the FINALS.
- A game is comprised of: 2 sets up to 21, set-3 up to 15, with a 2-point advantage.
- The winning team will be the CHAMPION of the Mamanet International Crown Tournament!
- The losing team will be the SECOND PLACE.
