General Terms:

- **The Competition Formula is final and is not subject to changes.**
- **The Tournament Administration reserves the right to change the games schedule and pools composition, even after publishing the game schedule.**
- **The Games rules and formula – the Official “Mamanet Rules of the Game” on the Mamanet website.**
- **POOL with 4 teams:**
 - **In the absence of 1 team - the pool will run a Double round-robin between all 3 remaining teams OR a team from a 5-team pool will be transferred to the pool of the 3 teams.**
 - **In the absence of 2 teams - the remaining 2 teams will move to other pools.**
- **POOL with 5 teams:**
 - **In the absence of 1 team - the pool will run in the same format of a 4-team pool.**
 - **In the absence of 2 teams - the pool will run a Double round-robin between all 3 remaining teams**
 - **In the absence of 3 teams - the remaining 2 teams will move to other pools.**
- **In case of a deviation from schedule, game times / score will be modified accordingly.**
- **The teams are responsible for bringing their own balls for warm-up and for the matches.**
- **Each team is required to arrive 40 minutes before their match starting time and register at the registration table.**

- The teams are responsible to arrive on time at the correct venue in accordance with the games schedule and the detailed transportation plan.
- A team that will be late for their requested arrival time will suffer a technical loss and will be liable to disqualification from the tournament.
- Under any circumstances, a court will not remain unoccupied. In case a match ends earlier than expected, the consequent matches will be expedited overwhelmingly.
- All the games of all next stages, after the POOLS stage, will be published on the Games Board hung at the YMCA Sports Center and notified through the Captains' WhatsApp group.
- All captains will be connected to the WhatsApp group in order to receive information and notifications regarding updates for the next Stages games schedule.
- Dressing code: Tournament shirt, unified colored pants & sports shoes.
- Shirts cuttings are forbidden - a player with a cut shirt will not be allowed to play.
- During the match – Every team will place their bags and belongings behind the players' bench.
- At the end of the match – Every team is responsible to leave the bench area clean and organized in a tidy manner.
- For any question or clarification – only the team captain can address the Professional staff.
- All participants are requested to respect the decisions of the Referees and Professional staff.

Score Calculation Method in the POOL Stage:

- Table Points:
 - Win – two (2) points
 - Loss – one (1) point
 - Technical Loss - zero (0) points
- In case of a table points tie, the ranking will be determined by the Set (Win to Lose) Ratio.
- In case of a set ratio tie, the ranking will be determined by the match point (Win to Lose) Ratio.
- In case of a Game Points Ratio tie, the ranking will be determined by the winner of the game between the two teams.

Score Calculation Method in the other Stages:

- Each team will qualify to the next stage only by winning and losing.
- Teams Ranked 21-29 – All teams will play 2 matches of a single set to determine their Final ranking.
- The remaining 20 teams (comprising 75% of all 29 participating teams) will still be able to qualify up to the FINALS.

Competition Formula:

Stage 1 - POOLS (46 Games 1-46) - from 2/5/2020 11:30 AM - 2/6/2020 1:50 PM

- The 29 teams were randomly divided into 7 pools at a draw which took place on 1/12/20 at the Semi-yearly Professional Committee gathering.
- The draw determined the pools under the only constraint that teams from similar locality will be put in different pools (6 pools of 4 teams and 1 pool of 5 teams)
- The pools are named - A, B, C, D, E, F, G.

- The matches: Full matches comprised of two (2) sets up to 21, third (3) set up to 15, with a 2-point minimum lead.
- In each POOL - All teams will compete through a single round-robin to determine their internal POOL rankings.
- All points accumulated thus far in this stage – will be reset.
- All teams from all pools will be determined according to their achievements the POOLS stage inside a single unified Ranking Table comprised of 1 to 29.
- A special adjustment will be applied to teams originating from the 5-team pools, compared with 4-team pools.
- Teams Ranked 1-4 move directly into the 1/4 FINALS Stage.
- Teams Ranked 5-20 continue to the 1st and 2nd PHASES Stage.
- Teams Ranked 21-29 continue to the RANKING Stage.

Stage 2 – 1st PHASE (8 Games 47-54) - from 2/6/2020 4:00 PM - 2/6/2020 5:10 PM

- Teams Ranked 5-20 will compete for the right to reach the 2nd PHASE Stage:
 - Ranked 20 vs. Ranked 5
 - Ranked 19 vs. Ranked 6
 - Ranked 18 vs. Ranked 7
 - And so on...
- The matches: A match is comprised of one (1) set up to 21 with a 2-point minimum lead.
- A winning team qualifies to the next Stage: 2nd PHASE.
- A losing team continues to Ranking Games 13-20.

Stage 3 – 2nd PHASE (4 Games 55-58) - from 2/6/2020 5:45 PM - 2/6/2020 6:20 PM

- winning teams from the 1st PHASE stage (5-12) will compete for the right to qualify for the 1/4 FINALS stage:
 - Ranked 5/20 vs. Winner 12/13 from the POOLS stage
 - Ranked 6/19 vs. Winner 11/14 from the POOLS stage
 - Ranked 7/18 vs. Winner 10/15 from the POOLS stage
 - And so on...
- The matches: A match is comprised of one (1) set up to 21 with a 2-point minimum lead.
- A winning team qualifies to the next Stage: QUARTER (1/4) FINALS.
- A losing team continues to the Ranking Games 9-12.

Stage 4 - 1/4 FINALS (4 Games 59-62) - on 2/6/2020 at 7:30 PM

- Winning teams from 1/8 FINALS stage will compete for the right to reach the SEMI-FINALS.
 - Winner 5/12 vs. RANKED 4
 - Winner 6/11 vs. RANKED 3
 - Winner 7/10 vs. RANKED 2
 - Winner 8/9 vs. RANKED 1
- The matches: A match is comprised of one (1) set up to 21 with a 2-point minimum lead.
- A winning team qualifies to the next stage: SEMI (1/2) FINALS.
- A losing team continues to the Ranking Games 5-8.

Stage 5 - RANKING GAMES (18 Games 66-83) - from 2/6/2020 5:10 PM - 2/7/2020 10:20 AM

- Ranking Games – Teams 21-29 will be divided into 3 sub-ranking-pools in which they teams will run a single round-robin: Ranked 21-23, Ranked 24-26, Ranked 27-29.
- Ranking Games - 3-24 - will be a comprised of one (1) set up to 21 with a 2-point minimum lead.

Stage 6 – SEMI-FINALS (2 Games 63-64) - on 2/7/2020 at 8:00 AM

- Winning teams from 1/4 FINALS stage will compete for the right to reach the FINALS.
 - Winner 1 vs. Winner 4
 - Winner 2 vs. Winner 3.
- The matches: Full matches comprised of two (2) sets up to 21, third (3) set up to 15, with a 2-point minimum lead.
- A winning team qualifies to the next stage: FINALS.
- A losing team continues to the Ranking Games 3-4.

Stage 7 - FINAL GAME (1 Game 65) - on 2/7/2020 at 11:00 AM

- Winning teams from SEMI-FINALS stage will compete in the FINALS.
- Full match comprised of two (2) sets up to 21, third (3) set up to 15, with a 2-point minimum lead.
- The winning team will be the CHAMPION of the Mamanet - International Crown Tournament 2020!
- The losing team will be the FIRST RUNNER UP.
